Much has happened in the short two years since we last hosted the Presbytery of Arkansas:

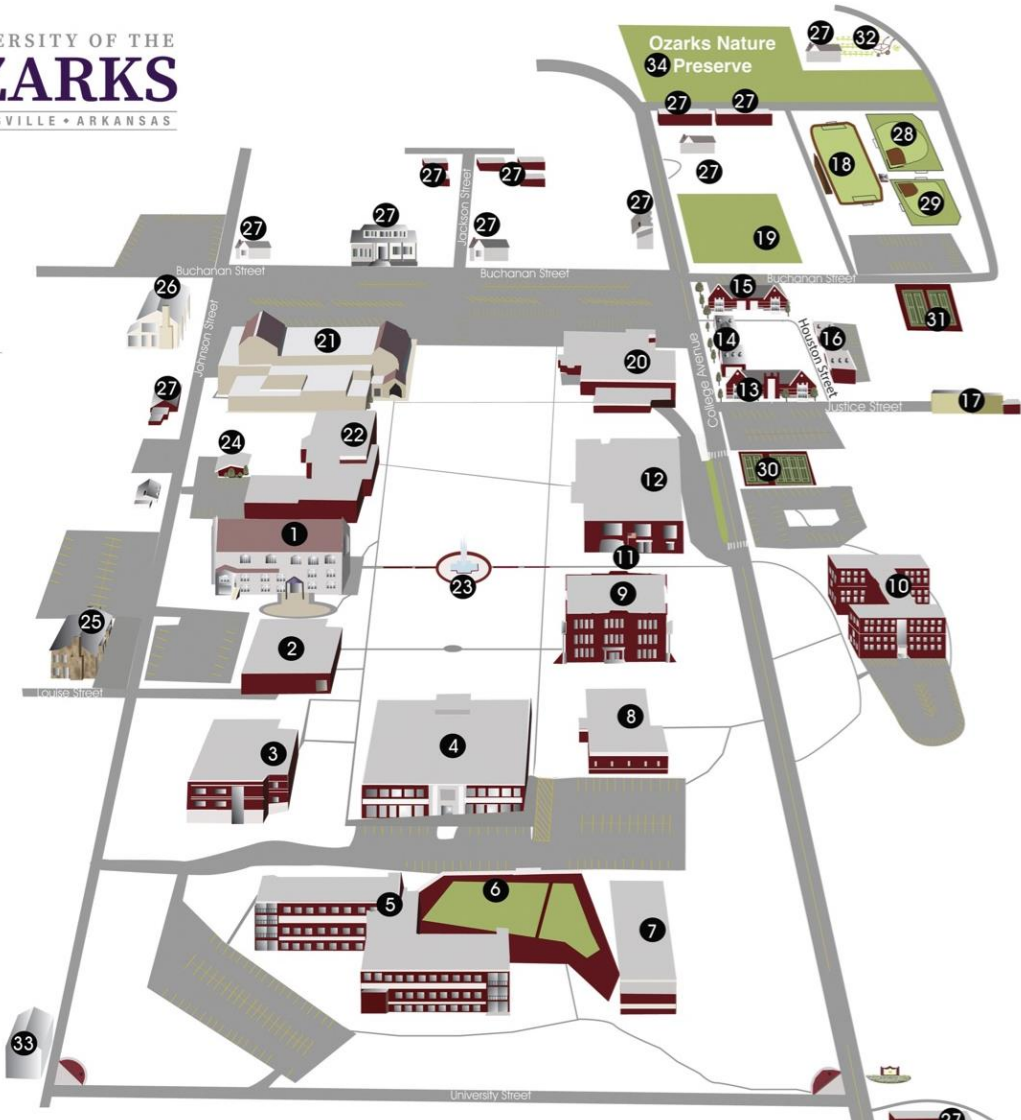

- We continue to work on holding down tuition and reducing the debt that our students incur with new financial aid opportunities such as the Frontier Scholarship and the Full Need Tuition Scholarship.
- In a covenant with First Presbyterian Church of Clarksville, we began hosting the church's weekly Sunday morning services in the recently renovated Munger-Wilson Memorial Chapel.
- We launched a campus-wide digital learning initiative, Compass, that lowers curriculum costs for students and enhances accessibility, creativity and innovation.
- We were ranked the No. 3 best college in the South Region for the third year in a row by *U.S. News & World Report* in its 2019 edition of America's Best Colleges.
- We are considered the No. 1 most diverse institution of higher education in the 12-state South Region.
- Our graduates continue to find success in securing employment and being accepted to graduate and professional schools as evidenced by a 98 percent post-graduate success rate within six months of graduating.

I am inspired daily by the unwavering loyalty and commitment to this University by our amazing alumni and friends who help ensure our ongoing success. It is my hope that during your time on campus, you feel that the relationship between and among members of the Presbytery of Arkansas and the University of the Ozarks is alive and well. We take seriously our long-standing affiliation with the Presbyterian Church and the pillars of higher education and are committed to learning and practicing Christian values, while respecting individual beliefs.

#### **Farmer Lecture: "Making a Difference in the World"**

*I choose to believe that most people hope to make a positive difference in the world. The trouble is that we often get hung up on the tactics and strategies of making that difference. Some hit the streets, others dive into history, others create, and still others think the most effective way to make change is to gathering communities together. ## What is the “Big Stuff” that will be at this upcoming Presbytery meeting?

- Plan to attend the Pre-Presbytery briefing by General Presbyter Stewart Smith on Friday afternoon at 5:00 pm during registration. This orientation to the business of the meeting is no longer just for first-time commissioners. Stewart will go through the docket and explain the primary pieces of business that will be before the Presbytery and answer questions. Look for the location of this briefing in the Main Packet when it is posted on-line.
- Former Moderator MWS Bruce Reyes-Chow will be leading two pre-presbytery workshops on Friday afternoon as well as leading the theological discussion on Friday evening. These are don't miss opportunities! Invite all members of your congregation to attend to learn and be inspired about moving the PC(USA) into God's future for us.
- At 10:30 am on Saturday morning the Coordinating Team will share the proposed “Implementation Plan” designed at a two-day retreat in January to assist the Presbytery as we live into the priorities affirmed at the June 2018 meeting of the Presbytery.
- The Youth and Young Adults Advisory Delegates will attend this meeting!!! God's Holy Spirit is always more evident at our Spring meeting when we experience the younger members of our congregations at work among us.
- We will hear about the proposed amendments to the *Book of Order* coming out of this past summer's General Assembly from the Presbytery's Polity Committee and vote on them on Saturday afternoon. The proposed amendments are posted on the website among packets for this meeting.
- Also a proposed amendment to the Presbytery of Arkansas' Ministry Manual will be voted on during the Coordinating Team's report early on Saturday morning. The text of that amendment is included, and explained, on the next page of this packet.



## **Proposed Amendment to the Presbytery of Arkansas' Ministry Manual**

The proposed amendment is to Part I: Organization and Structure, and is under 1) Presbytery. The Presbytery's Ministry Manual does not provide for the Moderator or Moderator in Waiting (Vice Moderator) to vote if that position is held by a Ruling Elder. The amendment would address that deficiency.

According to 8) Amendments, 1. Amending Organization and Structure:

“The Organization and Structure section may be amended by 3/5 vote of the Presbytery present and voting if the proposed amendment is distributed to all members and member congregations no less than 30 days prior to the meeting during which the vote is to take place. This rule may be waived by a 2/3 vote of the Presbytery present and voting.”

Proposed Amendment:

C. Membership- The membership of the Presbytery includes all Ministers of Word and Sacrament enrolled by the Presbytery and all congregations within its boundaries. **Ruling** Elders elected as General Presbyter, Stated Clerk, Assistant Stated Clerk, ~~or~~—**Treasurer, Moderator, and Moderator-in-Waiting (Vice Moderator)**; Commissioned Lay Pastors in current service; members of the Coordinating Team; ~~or~~**and** current commissioners to General Assembly shall be enrolled as members of the Presbytery during the term of elected service. **Ruling** Elders who are Certified Christian Educators as defined by the most recent edition of the *Book of Order* of the PC(USA) may be enrolled as members of the Presbytery.
