Members of the Central Arkansas Examinations Subcommittee of the Committee on Ministry of the Presbytery of Arkansas met on June 27, 2019 at the office of the Presbytery of Arkansas to conduct the examination of MWS Emily Hook for Membership in the Presbytery of Arkansas and for Pastor for Graham Memorial Presbyterian Church- Forrest City, Arkansas.

Emily is a member in good standing of Grand Canyon Presbytery. Her answers and discussions on examination topics were outstanding and she obviously possesses the qualifications for membership in the Presbytery of Arkansas.

Members of the PNC of Graham Memorial present were Carol Danehower, Berta Ann Elphingstone, Jo Patterson and Curt Patton. Chair Nancy Dunaway was unable to attend due to family illness. The members were invited to participate after the initial examination of Emily. The PNC has been extraordinarily diligent in its activities and recounted the number of PIF's reviewed, meetings held, and interviews conducted. Emily and her family intend to reside in the Marion, Arkansas area, due to the husband's work requirements. The PNC is aware of same. The Committee believed there to be a fit between Emily and Graham Memorial
