Report of Central Arkansas Examination Subcommittee
Examination of Susie Wright to be a
Commissioner Ruling Elder for Pastoral Care
Westminster Presbyterian Church-
Hot Springs, Arkansas**

September 26, 2019

Members of the Central Arkansas Examinations Subcommittee of the Committee on Ministry of the Presbytery of Arkansas met on September 26, 2019 at the office of the Presbytery of Arkansas to conduct the examination of Susie Wright to be a Commissioner Ruling Elder for Pastoral Care, Westminster Presbyterian Church, Hot Springs, Arkansas.

Members in attendance were: Retired MWS Don Campbell, Elder Wendell Phillips, Elder Jim Morehead, MWS Alisa Secrest, Retired MWS Carol Clark, Elder Vernon Markham, MWS Fern Davis, and Elder Don Eilbott, moderator.

Her Resume and Statement of Faith were reviewed and are attached.

Susie has been a member of Westminster for 40 years and has served in multiple positions. She earned a bachelor's degree from Arkansas Tech University. She completed her certification as an Associate Certified Christian Educator by the PC(USA) through courses at the Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary, trained as a Stephen Ministry Leader and graduated from the Presbytery of Arkansas Lay Academy in 2009.

She was examined in various areas of Presbyterian polity and theology. A separate request was made that she be authorized to serve the sacraments of communion and baptism. Accordingly, she was also examined in the meaning of those sacraments.

Elders Mary Ann Vest and Robin Morrison from Westminster were present and presented their endorsements of Susie and provided information concerning her past service to the Church.

MWS Chip Hatcher was present and recommended her being commissioned and stated that she could provide additional assistance by periodically being available to serve the sacrament of the Lord's Supper and perform baptisms.

The subcommittee unanimously sustained the examination of Susie Wright to be a Commissioner Ruling Elder for Pastoral Care, Westminster Presbyterian Church- Hot Springs, Arkansas for a period of one year with authorization to serve sacraments of communion and baptism.

The Employment Contract was reviewed, discussed and approved and is attached.

The meeting was closed with prayer by Susie.
