



Junior High Jubilee Mo-Ranch Camp in Hunt, TX July 2-7, 2022



Join us for Junior High Jubilee, a Presbyterian youth conference just for 6th-8th grade students!

Junior High Jubilee (JHJ) is an amazing youth conference that gathers junior highers from across the southern states! JHJ is a time to worship God, sing and dance, play in the rapids, make new friends in small groups, hang out with old AR Presby friends, and so much more. We hope you can join us for the fun! Let's go to Mo!

Who can go? Any current 6th-8th grader! Churches can sponsor a group of students, or students can register on their own. We also need 1 adult chaperone for every 5 students, and an adult or two who are willing to attend the conference as drivers! Adult chaperones and drivers must be 21 or older and pass a background check.



When is it? The JHJ trip is July 2-7, 2022. We'll gather in Fort Smith in the early afternoon on July 2, spend the night in Dalla, and then arrive at Mo-Ranch on July 3. Junior High Jubilee runs Sunday evening, July 3, through Thursday morning, July 7. We'll arrive back in Fort Smith on Thursday evening, July 7. We will travel in rented vehicles driven by volunteers from the Presbytery of Arkansas.



Where is it? Presbyterian Mo Ranch Assembly is near Hunt, TX. The Guadalupe River runs right through it, and it's simply beautiful! You'll get to play in the river, climb high ropes on the bluff tops, and stargaze during vespers!

How much does it cost? The trip will cost at *most* \$800. This includes conference costs, food and housing, transportation, and even an AR Presby T-shirt. Meals while traveling (1 lunch and 2 dinners) will be out-of-pocket.

How do I register? Register and pay your deposit via the buttons on:

If you register *and* you submit your deposit by December 20, you will receive \$50 off your final trip cost. Your trip cost must be paid in full by June 1, 2022.

Additional Information About Summer Trips with the Presbytery of Arkansas

Who is sponsoring these trips? The Youth A-Team of the Presbytery of Arkansas sponsors all summer trips. The Presbytery of Arkansas will handle all registration details, arrange transportation, and provide adult chaperons. The Presbytery also uses designated budgets to help supplement the cost of these trips.

What is the Youth A-Team? The Youth A-Team (Youth Advisory Team or YAT) is made up of youth (10th-12th graders), college-aged students, and adults who care about young people and about youth ministry. The Youth A-Team plans events and trips for the Presbytery of Arkansas. They accept new members every year; applications open in late spring for the following school year.

What happens after I register? You should receive an automatic reply from google forms after you register to confirm that your application has been received. Next, Brianne will send out confirmation emails after December 20 and January 15 to confirm that we have received your deposit and that your spot is secure. As the trip approaches, participants will receive more information about specific details for your trip!

If at any point, you do not receive the email communication that you are expecting, please reach out to Brianne immediately!

How can my church encourage youth to attend? Please share this information with all the youth connected to your church! Friends are welcome as well! The Youth A-Team encourages churches to help make these trips affordable by offering scholarships to participants connected to their congregations.
