On behalf of the members and officers, welcome to Central Presbyterian Church in the heart of historic downtown Russellville. We are so excited to host the presbytery meeting and be able to show off some of the good work being done here to promote the reign of Christ in the River Valley. Our location in a thriving retail and dining area two blocks from the Pope County Courthouse allows us to engage in some unique ministries to the community. We share space with CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) of the 5th Judicial District and Duvall Family Insurance which specializes in low-cost Medicare supplements for low-income individuals. We are also becoming a center for community activities such as art exhibitions for the River Valley Arts Center, recitals for the Arkansas Tech University music department, and open houses for the Russellville Community Market. When we say that we are central to the community, we mean it.

The Russellville historic district is undergoing a massive infrastructure improvement project, so you might experience some parking headaches with certain roads and/or sidewalks closed due to construction. The construction around the church is scheduled to be completed before the meeting. However, weather conditions may slow progress, and the cement might not be ready for pedestrian traffic. We apologize for any inconvenience. There is ample parking in our lot but maybe not enough for everyone. There is a covered portico for pick-up and drop-off at the main entrance located on the N. El Paso St side of the building where the meeting will be conducted.

Quiznos will be providing boxed meals for those who prepurchase lunch. If you choose to leave there are several options within walking distance including Fat Daddy's BBQ, Pasta Grill, TACO, Old Bank Bar and Grill, and The Burrito Bank. If you need a jolt of caffeine on your way into town, Midtown Coffee is an excellent local shop with two locations on N. Arkansas Ave, one beside the McDonald's and one in City Mall.

We will be meeting in Knox Hall which is through the red doors on the N. El Paso St side of the building and straight ahead. Registration will be in the hallway outside Knox Hall. Restrooms are located to the right of Knox Hall as you enter from the parking lot. The Wi-Fi network is **Central Pres-Knox Hall**. The password is **400WMain**. We are encouraging our members to wear their CPC t-shirts for the meeting. If you have any questions, please ask someone in a royal blue shirt with the Central logo on it.
